The Hannah Rose Angell Bassett Scholarship is a \$ 500 educational award given in memory of the life of  
Hannah Rose Angell Bassett and her contributions to the Binghamton community.

Hannah Rose Angell was born in Exeter, Otsego County, New York on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 1818. She married Dr.  
William H. Bassett in 1844 and raised her family and son, James Angel Bassett, in Morris, New York. In  
1863, along with her husband and son, she came to Binghamton and made it her home. Hannah Rose  
came from an early pioneer family that settled in Otsego County in the mid 1700's and who had earlier  
helped settle Providence, Rhode Island at the time Roger Williams fled England to America because of  
religious persecution. She had an extended circle of friends by whom she was held in high esteem and  
with her husband in their quiet way they enjoyed them to the fullest extent possible.
